For your guidance, only employees who worked 500 or more hours in the labor contract year 2019/2020 are participants in the Vacation Plan and only those who worked 700 or more hours are participants in the Holiday Plan. Receipt of a Summary Annual Report for one or more of the New Orleans Employers - ILA Plans does not necessarily mean that participant status has been achieved in that Plan.

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This is a summary of the annual report for the New Employers - International Longshoremen's Association, AFL-CIO Welfare Plan (EIN 72-0570875; Plan No. 501) for October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

INSURANCE INFORMATION

The Board of Trustees of the New Orleans Employers - ILA, AFL-CIO Welfare Plan has committed itself to pay all temporary disability income claims incurred under the terms of the Plan on a self-insured basis.

The Plan has an insurance policy with The Union Labor Life Insurance Company (ULLICO) covering group life and accidental death and dismemberment claims. The premiums paid to ULLICO under the Group Life and AD&D policies for the period beginning January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019 were \$541,993.

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The value of Plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the Plan was \$1,053,185 as of September 30, 2020, compared to \$1,109,077 as of October 1, 2019. During the Plan year the Plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$55,892. During the Plan year, the Plan had total income of \$1,130,298 including a transfer from the NOE-ILA Royalty Escrow Account of \$1,113,168 earnings from investments of \$5,766, and other income of \$11,364.

Total Plan expenses were \$1,186,190. These expenses included \$521,379 in administrative expenses and \$664,811 in benefits, costs incurred to provide benefits, and premiums paid or accrued. A total of 1,584 people were participants in or beneficiaries of the Plan at the end of the Plan year.

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This is a summary of the annual report for the New Employers - International Longshoremen's Association, AFL-CIO Welfare Plan (EIN 72-0570875; Plan No. 502) for October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

INSURANCE INFORMATION

The Board of Trustees of the New Orleans Employers - ILA, AFL-CIO Welfare Plan for Non-Medicare Eligible Retired Employees and Dependents has committed itself to pay all medical, prescription and mental health claims incurred under the terms of the Plan. The Plan has an administrative services agreement with Zenith American Solutions to process and pay all medical claims and with Magellan Behavioral Health to pay all mental health claims.

The Plan receives monthly reimbursement payments from the MILA Managed Health Care Trust Fund for the cost of the medical/mental health claims and third party administrative fees. The MILA Plan administers the prescription benefit claims through its third party administrator and pays directly for those claims.

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The value of Plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the Plan was \$(151,700) as of September 30, 2020, compared to \$(107,800) as of October 1, 2019. During the Plan year the Plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$43,900. During the Plan year, the Plan had total income of \$827,466 including retired employee contributions of \$32,895, a transfer from the NOE-ILA Royalty Escrow Account of \$115,832 and reimbursement payments from the MILA Plan of \$678,739.

Total Plan expenses were \$871,366. These expenses included \$111,596 in administrative expenses and \$759,770 in benefits and costs incurred to provide benefits. A total of 60 people were participants of the Plan at the end of the Plan year.

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This is a summary of the annual report for the New Orleans Employers - International Longshoremen's Association, AFL-CIO Vacation and Holiday Plan, (EIN 72-0501072; Plan No. 502) for October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Benefits under the Plan are provided by royalty contributions which are invested and held in a Trust account of a national bank. Plan expenses for the year were \$1,781,555. These expenses included \$1,718,348 in benefits paid or accrued to participants for the 2019/2020 Plan Year and \$63,207 in administrative expenses. A total of 601 people were participants in or beneficiaries of the Plan at the end of the Plan year, most of which participants received both Vacation and Holiday benefits.

The value of Plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the Plan was \$895,855 as of September 30, 2020 compared to \$949,894 as of October 1, 2019. During the Plan year, the Plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$54,039. The Plan had total income of \$1,727,516 including a transfer from the NOE-ILA Royalty Escrow Account of \$852,996 a transfer from the Container Royalty Fund No.5 of \$863,552, and earnings from investments of \$10,968.
