Will End on May 11, 2023

On January 31, 2020, the Department of Health and Human Services declared the public health emergency which has been extended multiple times.

On January 30, 2023, the Biden administration announced that it would end the public health emergency and the national emergency related to COVID-19 on May 11, 2023.

Mid Central Operating Engineers Health and Welfare Fund will cease providing coverage without cost sharing, Effective, May 12, 2023 with the exception of the COVID-19 vaccine.

What this means to you and your family:

- COVID-19 vaccinations will be covered at 100%, no deductible recommended by American Academy of Pediatrics and Adult Immunization Schedule and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, (CDC).

- Over-the-counter COVID-19 test kits will no longer be covered.
- Benefits for COVID-19 diagnosis and all related services will no longer be covered at 100% effective May 12, 2023. Your deductible and out of pocket (when applicable) will apply to all COVID-19 diagnosis and related services, effective, May 12, 2023
