## TO ALL EMPLOYERS OF CEMENT MASONS' UNION LOCAL 502 - PLASTERERS' AREA 5

This will officially serve to inform you that on <u>June 1, 2020 a \$2.35 increase</u> will be effective in accordance with our **Three Year Contract Agreement**. At a Special Meeting of the Executive Board on April 16, 2020 the Executive Board voted to allocate <u>\$5.50</u> in the category of **WAGES** and \$1.85 in the category of **FRINGES**.

In the category of **FRINGES**, the Executive Board voted to allocate an additional \$.85 to the **PENSION**, \$.75 to the **HEALTH & WELFARE**, and \$.25 to the **RETIREE WELFARE**. **WORKING DUES** will remain at 4.5% of the total package. The rates effective <u>June</u> 1, 2020 to May 31, 2021 are as follows:

Dues deductions for Apprentice Plasterers shall be \$3.10 per hour.
