SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

This is a summary of the annual report for the Iron Workers District Council of Western New York and Vicinity Retiree Supplemental Benefit Plan (the "Plan" or "Retiree Plan"), EIN 16-1550492, Plan No. 502, for the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

The value of Plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$2,366,578 as of June 30, 2019, compared to \$2,083,296 as of July 1, 2018. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$283,282. The Plan's income consisted of funding transfers from the Iron Workers District Council of Western New York and Vicinity Supplemental Benefit Plan (Active Participants) (the "Active Plan") totaling \$467,065.

Benefits paid under the Plan to participants and beneficiaries amounted to \$183,783. A total of 122 persons were participants in the Plan.
