
MFA for I-Site


Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) was established on I-Site in July 2025 to offer more protection to the Health Fund website, I-Site.

Initially, members will be prompted to have a verification code emailed to the email the Health Fund has on file linked to I-Site. A text message code is available and can be established once in I-Site.

Click "Send Email to", then you will be prompted for a Security code which will be emailed.




Change Contact Method is only available if the Fund Office has both an Email and SMS phone on file for I-Site. To add a cell number for text messaging, please see To add a SMS Cell Number on Isite on page 3.



Enter the code provided and click on VERIFY.

To add a SMS Cell Number on I-Site: Establish a Cell Phone number to get the MFA code texted instead of emailed.

Once logged into I-Site, click on "My Account" on the upper right.




This is where you can update credentials, security question and password, and add a mobile phone number.



Click on "Change" and the screen will adjust so a cell phone can be added. Click on the "Add Cell Phone" Button.

Once the Cell phone is entered, a text message will be sent to verify the number. This text message is going to be what future text messages will look like if you select to receive your code via text.







Current Password
