

We would like to take the time to address any confusion surrounding how to correctly identify and utilize your UnitedHealthcare Group Medicare Advantage PPO and Prescription Plan (MAPD) ID Card. Please refer to the correct Wisconsin Electrical Employees Health and Welfare Fund example ID Card below. The correct ID Card will contain 'WEEH&W PLAN' above the Medicare Rx box, the Group Number: 15590, as well as 'UnitedHealthcare Group Medicare Advantage (PPO)' on the front of the card. Please utilize this ID Card at all physician and hospital visits as well as at the pharmacy accompanied by your Sav-Rx Secondary Wrap ID Card.
