# Warning Signs Rarely any warning signs Victims Response Loses consciousness or is found unconscious. May be found gasping for air. Risk of Death Death can occur within minutes with out shock from AED. What to do

### What is a Heart Attack?

A heart attack is a "Circulation" problem.



Heart attack occurs when the blood flow to the heart is blocked.

# **Employee-Only Benefits**

The amount of your life insurance benefit is determined by your length of employment and unit coverage as shown below.

# Unit 1

| At least 1 year but less than 10 years   | \$10,000 |
|--|----------|
| At least 10 years but less than 15 years | \$15,000 |
| At least 15 years but less than 20 years | \$20,000 |
| 20 plus years                            | \$25,000 |

# Unit 2

| At least 1 year but less than 10 years   | \$2,000  |
|--|----------|
| At least 10 years but less than 15 years | \$5,000  |
| At least 15 years but less than 20 years | \$10,000 |
| 20 plus years                            | \$15,000 |
