## Improved Coverage for Diagnostic Radiology Services Effective January 1, 2019

As the Board of Trustees of the United Food & Commercial Workers Union Local 655 Welfare Fund (the "Fund"), our goal is to ensure the Fund provides comprehensive, affordable healthcare benefits that meet the needs of our participants and your eligible dependents. In keeping with that goal, beginning January 1, 2019, the Fund will contract with Absolute Solutions so that you and your dependents may receive necessary MRI, CT and PET scans at no additional cost.

- Go in-network and save money! You are still able to use a provider in the current Aetna network. However, when your scan is performed by an Absolute Solutions network provider, you will have no out-of-pocket costs. If your scan is performed by a provider who does not participate in the Absolute Solutions network, you will have to meet your calendar year deductible and pay your coinsurance toward the cost of the service.
- Just make a simple phone call. Call Absolute Solutions at (800) 321-5040 whenever your doctor wants you to get an MRI, CT or PET scan performed. A representative will schedule and manage your diagnostic radiology test from beginning to end. Since there is an extensive network of providers in the Greater St. Louis area alone who contract with Absolute Solutions—and the entire network consists of over 3,600 hospitals, independent facilities and medical centers nationwide—the representative should have no problem finding a network provider for you.

We recommend that you take advantage of this cost-saving benefit whenever you need an MRI, CT and/or PET scan performed. The Absolute Solutions network is a cost savings to both you and your Fund.
